- ✓ Tea - bags & loose leaf
- ✓ Foodware marked compostable
- ✓ Wood chopsticks & cutlery
- ✓ Pizza boxes* & wax paper liners

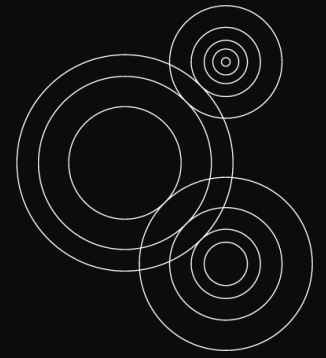

BATTERIES & E-WASTE



Electronic waste or e-waste includes any electronic items that are old, broken, or obsolete.

UBCO CAP 2030 target:

- ✓ 50% less waste per capita by 2030, progressing toward a zero-waste community

Accepted:

- ✓ Small e-waste (smartwatches, earbuds, adapters, and cords)
- ✓ Batteries under 5kg (excluding car and boat batteries)
- ✓ Cell phones



Keep Out:

- ✗ Damaged batteries
 - ⇒ Reach out to HSE for assistance
- ✗ Larger e-waste
